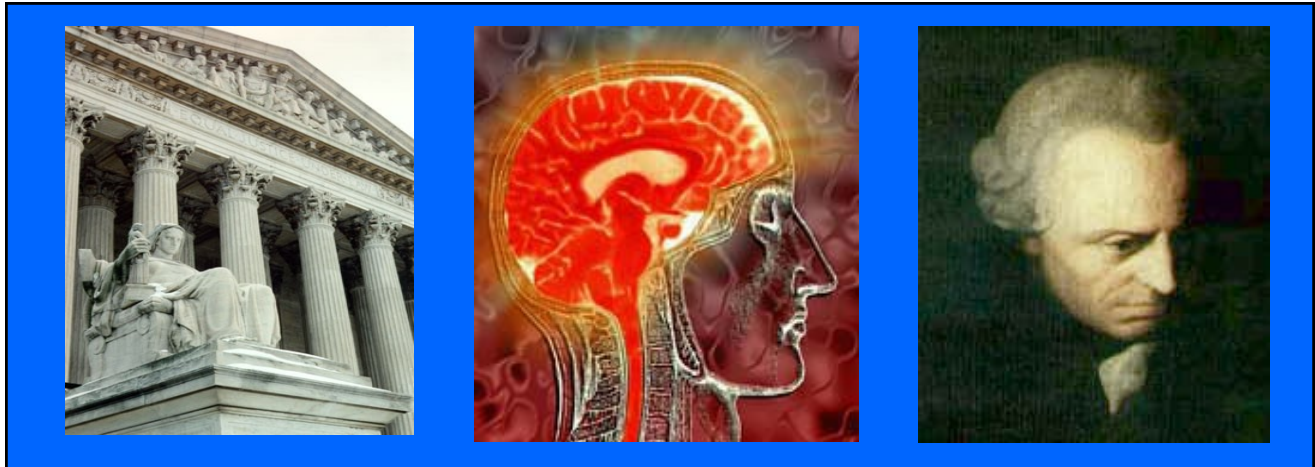

 - ◆ \$12,000/year
 - ◆ teaching duties in 2nd year
- ◆ German Philosophy Scholarship
 - ◆ \$12,000/year
 - ◆ teaching duties in 2nd year
- ◆ Up to 20 Assistantships
 - ◆ \$5,000-\$10,000/year
